As per Article No. 40.2 of General Prescriptions you are reminded that "SOS" & "OK" signs are provided in your Road Book.

In event of accident where NO injuries are sustained requiring immediate medical intervention, the "OK" sign must be clearly shown by crewmember to next 3 following vehicles.

If Crewmember leaves the vehicle, the "OK" sign must be displayed so that it is clearly visible, where possible, to other competitors.

The following 3 competitors **must flash the head lights** to the next TWO radio points for confirming that the competitors at the incident dose not require immediate medical intervention. Also inform the stage safety officer at the "STOP" control at each stage.

If on other hand urgent medical attention is required, where possible "SOS" should immediately displayed to next following car/s. It is MANDATORY for following car to stop and render assistance and fill up the "Accident Emergency Procedure Form" printed on orange sheet in road book. The second car at the scene must collect "Accident / Emergency Procedure Form" from the first car & proceed to next Radio Point and hand over the form to the officials.

In case of NO sign shown by the competitors the following 3 competitors must asses the situation and must inform the next radio point either Flashing the Head Lights for "OK" or stop and inform about the immediate medical intervention.

**Any crew, which is able to, but fails to comply with this rule may be penalised by Stewards in accordance with the International Sporting Code.**
