5. Service park & Stages

The Service Park and Parc Fermé for the **Rally of Maharashtra 2025** will be set up at **SAPKAL KNOWLEDGE HUB**, which offers a vast and scenic campus with concrete courts designated for rally operations.

Important Instructions (Strictly Enforced)

- **Nailing, drilling, or any form of fixing on the concrete surface is STRICTLY NOT PERMITTED.**
- Teams must exercise extreme caution while handling **engine oils, lubricants, fuel, spare parts, and waste materials**.
- Any form of damage, staining, or spoiling of the concrete surface or college premises must be strictly avoided.
- **Smoking is permitted only in the designated smoking zone. Smoking in any other area is strictly prohibited.**
- Please remember that this is an **educational institution**, and **school and college students will be present as spectators**. Teams are expected to conduct themselves professionally and set a positive example for motorsport.
- **All teams must strictly adhere to the FMSCI Environmental Policy and Sustainability Guidelines in all respects.** Non-compliance may attract penalties.

SSS: The 2 km stage will be run on internal tarmac roads within Grape County Eco Resorts & Spa. The route winds around a scenic lake and features several spectacular turns and a donut. Last year we had over 5000+ spectators.

POSHERA Stage (ALPHA) – 9 km: This is a wide and very fast stage, comprising a mix of long straights and flowing ghat sections. The road allows high average speeds, demanding strong commitment and precise pace judgment. The stage passes through Hirawe village, where an artificial chicane has been introduced to significantly reduce speed and ensure safety. Surface grip is generally consistent, but caution is advised through elevation changes and transitions between straight sections and hill roads. High spectator presence is expected, as two approach roads provide easy access to the stage even while it is live; competitors must strictly adhere to caution zones and marshal instructions.

KAROLI Stage (BETA) – 7 km: This is a narrow and highly technical stage featuring multiple crests, several of which may cause the cars to become light or airborne, offering excellent photographic opportunities. The road camber changes frequently throughout the stage, demanding accurate speed assessment and precise vehicle placement. Limited road width and restricted run-off leave little margin for error. Competitors are advised to exercise caution, particularly over blind crests and during camber transitions. This stage runs over the same road section used in the RALLY OF MAHARASHTRA 2024, but in the opposite direction.

KALAMB Stage (GAMMA) – 19.5 km:

This is the *game-deciding* stage of the rally. The opening 6 km are wide and extremely fast, allowing very high average speeds. After Dandwal village, the surface becomes slightly rough for approximately 1 km, requiring careful wheel placement. From there, the stage turns into a winding uphill section up to around the 12 km mark, demanding

sustained concentration and rhythm. The final sector is a fast, winding downhill ghat that leads into a spectacular flying finish. Overall, the stage remains wide throughout, with the notable exception of a long, narrow bridge that requires extra caution.

Rally Secretariat opens on Thursday, 26th FEB 2026, 13:00 hours to enable competitors to finish the administrative checks and get their document "OK", to be handed over to the scrutineers before presenting their car for scrutiny.

Final Scrutineering will be at Rally HQ2 on Sunday, 1st MARCH 2026 at 14:00 hours.

Places to visit in Nashik

B.A.P.S Swami Narayan Mandir (22.3km From Rally HQ)

B.A.P.S. Swami Narayan Mandir in Panchavati is a grand stone-carved shikhar-baddh temple on the banks of the river Godavari. It has walkways around the central shrine to allow worshipers to circumambulate the shrine. It is decorated with designs and inlaid marble.

In Swaminarayan temple, the statues of Radha, Krishna, Sita, Ram, Lakshmi Narayan dev, Vitthal Rakhumai, Ganapati, Hanuman and Mahadev have been placed.

Shree Kalaram Mandir (21.5km from Rally HQ)

Shree Kalaram Mandir was built in 1782 at the site of an old wooden structure where Lord Ram is believed to have lived during exile. Kalaram Temple, is a Hindu temple in Nashik of Nashik district in Maharashtra, dedicated to the deity Rama. It is a temple situated in Panchavati area of the Nashik. The temple derives its name from a black statue of Rama.



Trimbakeshwar (14km from Rally HQ)

Located at a distance of 30 km is Trimbakeshwar. Trimbakeshwar town is an ancient Hindu Pilgrim centre located at the source of the Godavari River, the longest river in peninsular India. Trimbakeshwar is located at the foot of Brahmagiri hill, height of which is 3000 feet above sea level.


Trimbakeshwar is abode of one of the twelve Jyotirlingas. The temple is located between three hills namely Brahmagiri, Nilagiri and Kalagiri. The temple has three lingas (an iconic form of Shiva) representing Shiva, Vishnu and Brahma.

Anjaneri (7.7km from Rally HQ)

Located 20 km away from Nashik towards Trimbakeshwar road, Anjaneri hills hold a lot of historical and religious significance. As per the Hindu mythology, Anjaneri is the birthplace of Lord Hanuman. Caves, temples, waterfalls and lakes are some of the common sights along the short trek to Anjaneri Fort. Anjaneri is an attraction of Nasik city, which is also an important fort in the Trimbakeshwar region. Situated at 4,264 feet (1,300 m) above sea level, it lies between Nasik and Trimbakeshwar near Godavari river. It neighbors the Brahmagiri range, significant in Hindu traditions as a meditation spot of Sage Gautam.

At a distance of 19 km from Nashik and 3 km from Anjaneri, the Coin Museum, located in the campus of the Indian Institute of Research in Numismatic Studies, is on the Nashik-Trimbakeshwar road.

The displays in the museums comprise of coins, moulds, dyes, replicas, photographs, numismatic material, along with bronze, terracotta's, copper-hoard objects, paintings and some historical artefacts.

SULA (14km from Rally HQ)

Nashik is recognised as the "Wine Capital of India" due to its abundance of vineyards and wineries. India's leading producer of wines, Sula Vineyards is located amidst the rolling hills of Nashik overlooking the Gangapur Dam.



Nashik is also known throughout India for **Misal Pav**, which is a popular Maharashtrian street food that comprises of sprouts curry, topped with onions, tomatoes, farsan (fried savory mixture), lemon juice, coriander leaves and served with a side of soft bread(pav).
